
Camp Sagonaska - A much darker site than previously thought!



The light pollution map on the left - centred on Camp Sagonaska where we hold Fall 'n' Stars - was made from the World Atlas of the Artificial Night Sky Brightness and, unknowingly, was made from images when there was significant snow cover where the results were skewered to show local light pollution worse than it actually is. The revised one on the right shows that rather than being in the green area, Fall 'n' Stars is held in blue territory which is good for being south of HWY 7. Sky Quality Meter readings that I have taken confirm this as we tend to average around 21.35.
